



This may be your last chance to train your workforce for next to nothing!

Many of you have already taken advantage of the funding dollars we have received through the Community Development Trust Fund to train your workers in resource road driving, ATV operations, and supervisor skills for as little as \$100 per seat for non-in-house courses.

This funding is set to expire in March 2011, which means you might not have your work force ready to train before you start the new season. It also means that in meeting your future training obligations, training costs will rise substantially next year. To help assist you save money now and meet your due diligence for training workers to an industry standard, the WSCA is hosting a number of regional training sessions for silviculture CU based companies this Fall. Non-silviculture CU's are welcome to attend as well.
